

## Roscommon County CAD-RMS-JMS

### Multijurisdictional Project

#### QAs

1. **Q:** Is Crawford County involved or is Roscommon doing this alone?

**A: At the time of RFI publication this project would not be shared by another county. Crawford County will not be part of this project.**

2. **Q:** Can you provide clarification on Section II, J and K and the differences between these two sections? For instance, Section J indicates that there are currently 7 existing CAD licenses (4 gray) but Section K is indicating that there are actually 10 workstations where the software is needed. Is section J what you have now and Section K is what you would like to have?

**A: Section J is existing licenses and position. Section K is potential numbers for the final purchase. Gray positions are those that are licensed for use but are not used 24/7/365. It may not be pertinent to your RFI if no discount for these gray positions.**

3. **Q:** Under Section III, H, 4, c data conversion of all data and attached files is referenced. Is this for only the OSSI CAD system currently used by Roscommon County Central Dispatch or also the FSG LEMS system used by Roscommon County Sheriff for RMS and JMS? What about any other agencies like the two using Caliber?

**A: The intent is all data for all the different systems. We understand that is a very large request. That being said, it is a starting point. If multi-system full data conversion is possible, what are the costs, etc.**

4. **Q:** Section III, C, 4 relates to firearm registration. This is typically handled through the MICJIN portal. Does Roscommon County do this through the RMS instead or what is the need here?

**A: This is an item separate from the State registration process. Departments would use this for their internal portion of the process.**

5. **Q:** Section II, A indicates: All agencies are open to explore mobile AVL, report writing, and limited-CAD functionality in a mobile device .What is Mobile referring to? An in car computer or does a mobile device refer to a phone?

**A: This is referring to MPCs, MDTs, and other portable devices (tablets) to facilitate in-field report writing and ability to see CAD and records from the field. Mobile Personal Computers (Laptops), Mobile Data Terminals (pretty much same as MPC), and tablets. If there is any phone functionality available, the same questions would apply.**

6. **CAD:**

**Q:** How many Admin CAD stations are there?

**A: Everything is permission based. We have two or three people with full administrative rights. I can sign in to any CAD position and those rights follow me.**

**Q:** Who is the E911 phone vendor?

**A: We currently use Intrado's Viper System. Formerly West Safety Services.**

7. **RMS:** Relating to users of the RMS:

**Q:** How many concurrent full time/daily-use users does each Law Enforcement Agency in the County have?

**A: I believe this is answered by Section II - Background, subparagraphs A through K. J is the paragraph of existing license/positions. K is the potential to expand to.**

**Q:** How many concurrent part time /infrequent-use users does each Law Enforcement Agency in the County have?

**A: I'm not clear if this is what you are referring to our "Gray" licenses or actual part-time personnel. I do not have counts for part-time personnel for the law enforcement departments.**

**Q:** How many concurrent users of Civil does the Sheriff's Department have?

**A: One**

8. **JMS:**

**Q:** How many beds does the Jail have?

**A: 96**

**Q:** Who is the commissary vendor that the JMS would need to integrate with?

**A: Stellar**
